## About the School

### PHYSICAL INFRASTRUCTURE AND FACILITY

Our physical infrastructure spreads across 5 acres of land. The school building consists of ground, first, second, third floor which comprises well equipped labs (Computer, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, Composite), updated libraries, audio-visual room (Smart Class), multipurpose auditorium, a projector room, a music room, activity room, spacious and airy classrooms, hygienic washrooms, CWSN washrooms, well trained and equipped cleaning and support staff, round the clock security system with CCTV cameras around the entire school campus, with complete state-of-the-art fire safety system installed inside the school building, internet connectivity, purified drinking water facility on each floor.

Our sports infrastructure comprises a huge play field, badminton/volleyball/basketball court, park for junior section with state-of-the-art latest outdoor play equipment, huge playground, multipurpose play area for toddlers, A new building block is under construction, which will have new classrooms, new restrooms, two multipurpose halls.

### CURRICULUM AND TEACHERS

The curriculum of Utkarsh International School has been designed keeping in mind the New Education Policy 2020 which primarily emphasises mainly on inclusive education, skill-based learning, active partnership between parent and school, experiential learning and multilingualism. The aim is to promote holistic growth with intellectual and academic growth. Skill based learning module integrates vocational training, digital literacy and life skills into the curriculum to promote hands-on-learning. UIS has included subjects like artificial intelligence, robotics and financial literacy from classes 6 to 8 and optional subjects like IT, healthcare and marketing for classes 9 to 12. Our curriculum also includes SEVA (social empowerment through work education and action) which is a mandatory initiative by CBSE. It has been designed to bridge the gap between classroom learning and the real world. Our students participate in various non-profit and social activities which promote active citizenship, critical-thinking and problem-solving. Regular educational field trips also aim to encourage holistic growth and experiential learning. Our teachers prioritize need-based learning, which focuses on each child's individual needs. Assessment is primarily competency-based assessment which evaluates an individual's ability to apply specific knowledge or skill in real-world or simulated scenarios. Our curriculum and teaching method aims to build confidence and shape personalities along with everyday learning. With our innovative approach and experienced faculty, well equipped labs laced with modern technology an integrated program for classes IX to XII have been initiated, which aims to prepare our students for competitive exams like NEET, IIT-JEE, CLAT, CUET and

various Olympiads. Physical fitness is an integral part of the curriculum at UIS, it is significant for holistic development and mental well-being. Students' mental-health is a priority at UIS, regular counselling sessions with an experienced and qualified counsellor builds self-esteem and character which are paramount for their holistic growth. The curriculum also includes various co-curricular activities which are essential for overall development, physical and mental-well being, essential life-skills, better social-skills which eventually improves academic performance and enriches their understanding of themselves and the world. It gives students a chance to explore various career options at an early stage. Various clubs at school level help students focus better, manage time and stay disciplined. Clubs are like small communities within the school, where students with similar interests collaborate effectively and build long-lasting friendships.

## Admission Procedure

**Class Nursery :** Dates of interactive sessions of short listed candidates will be informed by SMS and e-mail only. Due to the limited number of seats available, all applicants may not be accommodated. Hence only short listed candidates will be informed along with further detailed instructions by SMS and e-mail only. Kindly note that the eligible candidate for Nursery should be above 3 years of age. Kindly note the following : No form will be issued or received after the due date.

**CLASS KG TO V :** Parents to apply for admission to Classes KG to V in the month of February-March. This is against any vacancy in the said class .If the child is short listed, he/she will be called for an admission test in the month of March/April.

**CLASS VI TO IX & XI :** Application forms are available only if there is a vacancy. Parents to apply for admission to Classes VI to IX & XI in the month of February-March. If the child is short listed, he/she will be called for an admission test in English, Mathematics, Hindi and Science in the month of March/April .

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS:\*

- All the students are required to pay Fee for all twelve months (March-April). Fees will be submitted in quarterly installments i.e three months, for eg, April+May+June.
- The school authority reserves its right to any change in the Fee Structure as per the school policy or any guidelines issued by the government authorities.
- Payment can be done in cash or by cheque made in favor of 'Utkarsh International School'.
- The school offers scholarships based on the result of the Admission Test. Children scoring 90% and above in the admission test will get monthly scholarships.
- The school offers Fee Relaxation based on the following criteria :
  - Below Poverty Line/Low Income Group : Parents who have BPL cards will get Fee Relaxation of 30% on their monthly Fee.
- Late Fee charges shall be applicable after 10th of every month. 11th-30th of the same month-Rs. 10 (per day), 1-15th of the next month- Rs. 20 (per day), after 15th of the next month- name of the student will be struck off from the Admission Roll and parents will have to pay Re-Admission charges of INR 5000, along with a written application addressed to the Principal of the School.
- Transportation Charges are subject to change depending upon the CNG price, Driver Charges and Van Maintenance Fee. \* School Authority reserves its right to any change in the Van Fee.
- Transportation Fee shall be charged monthly, including the month of June.

It offers an informal, social atmosphere for students to explore topics like cryptography, graph theory, and competition math while developing critical thinking and collaborative skills.

# Additional Curriculum in alignment with NEP 2020

## ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE -

We have introduced AI as a subject in classes 1 to 10 (Subject Code 417 and 843), with the aim to develop an understanding of AI and its implications on our society. This course is planned in a sequential manner for creating employability and professional skills among the students. For classes 3 to 5, an Introduction to AI & computational thinking, with approximately 50 hours of instruction will be implemented. For classes 6-12, 125 hours of AI and computational thinking, with dedicated Subject Code 417 for classes 9th and 10th. In lower classes, it is integrated with Maths, while in senior classes, it is a specialized subject supported by IBM. The curriculum covers Data, Computer Vision, and Natural Language Processing. It includes activities like hands-on projects, such as training models, "Rock, Paper and Scissors" (data-based), "Emoji Scavenger Hunt" (Computer Vision), and "Mystery Animal" (NLP). It focuses on skill development aiming to foster AI-readiness, ethical understanding, and real-world problem-solving.

## CODING -


Coding has been introduced from classes VI-VIII as a skill module, and is significant for building computational thinking, logical reasoning, and problem-solving skills early. It prepares students for a technology-driven future by fostering creativity, enhancing academic performance in STEM, and encouraging practical application through block-based and Python programming. Significance of Coding includes a) development of core skill, it fosters computational thinking, which allows students to break down complex problems into smaller, manageable parts. It also boosts logical, structural, and analytical thinking. b) Early exposure and preparation, from class 6 to 8 with 12-hour skill module encourages understanding how algorithms work. This early exposure lays the foundation for advanced, future-oriented topics like AI and data science. c) It enhances creativity and innovation-Coding is used to create digital projects, such as apps, games, and animations, which helps transform ideas into tangible, creative projects. d) Practical application (STEM), strengthens understanding in Mathematics and Science, enabling students to apply theoretical knowledge to practical scenarios. e) It makes children future ready as coding skills become essential for various fields, including data science, software development, and robotics. f) It has a pedagogical approach, CBSE utilizes gamified learning and block-based coding (such as on the Make Code platform) to make the learning experience engaging and intuitive. This integration aims to shift focus from rote memorization to skill-based learning, cultivating a generation of logical thinkers and innovators.

## ROBOTICS -

Robotics acts as a vital, hands-on tool that bridges theoretical knowledge with practical application, significantly enhancing STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) learning. It fosters critical 21st-century skills like computational thinking, innovation, problem-solving, and collaboration. By integrating robotics, we prepare students for future AI-driven careers through active learning and technical skill development.

## FINANCIAL LITERACY -

Incorporating financial literacy into the curriculum is crucial for teaching students essential life skills, including budgeting, saving, and investing, which fosters long-term financial independence and responsible money management. It empowers students to make informed decisions, avoid debt traps, and navigate a digital economy, while also promoting entrepreneurial thinking and reducing future financial stress.



## Publications

UIS publishes a number of magazines and journals. The published magazine highlights school's achievement and also showcases the creativity and writing/editing skills of students. The aim of such publication is to foster creative thinking, enhance writing skills, and provide a platform for students to express ideas. It serves as a repository for school memories and achievements, strengthens community bonds, and helps develop crucial skills like journalism and editing.

## Pre- Primery School

Pre-primary education (ages 3–6) is critical for holistic development, as over 85–90% of brain development occurs before age 6. It provides a strong foundation for future learning, social-emotional skills, cognitive growth, and physical health, significantly reducing school dropout rates and boosting long-term academic and economic outcomes. Our Pre-Primary section is recognised as ECCE (Early childhood care and education) which is defined as play-based, inquiry-based, and activity-based learning. A major focus is on preparing children for foundational literacy and numeracy, but through informal, age-appropriate methods rather than rigorous textbooks. ECCE heavily emphasizes learning in your mother tongue.

## Primery School

Our primary school offers a safe, nurturing environment with qualified teachers, a balanced curriculum (academics, arts, sports), and fosters holistic growth through play-based learning, technology, strong parent communication, character building (ethics, empathy), and developing critical thinking and social skills. The primary section spans ages 7-11 and is composed of the Foundational Stage including pre-school (classes I and II) and the Preparatory Stage (classes III to V). This framework emphasizes a shift to holistic, play-based learning and foundational literacy and numeracy, with instruction ideally in the home language/mother tongue up to Grade V.

## Middle School

Middle school comprises of three years of education, building on the pedagogical and curricular style of the primary school, but with the introduction of subject teachers for learning and discussion of the more abstract concepts in each subject that students will be ready for at this stage across the sciences, mathematics, arts, social sciences, and humanities. Experiential learning within each subject, and explorations of relations among different subjects, will be encouraged and emphasized despite the introduction of more specialized subjects and subject teachers.

## Senior School


